PIG DIG PIPELINE EXCAVATION & REPAIR

Ohio, Pennsylvania, Indiana, Illinois, Michigan, Iowa, & Missouri

RedHorse Environmental completes numerous environmental assessments at Pig-Dig locations to allow for the rapid repair or replacement of defective sections of pipelines to meet narrow regulatory windows. We employ a GIS based screening process that flags sites that may have regulated water resources (streams, wetlands). These sites are then evaluated in the field by our Senior staff using standard wetland delineation protocols (1987 U.S. Army Corps of Engineers Wetland Delineation Manual and supplements). We then work with the client and contractor to avoid impacts to regulated resources and/or secure all Federal or State environmental permits when impacts are unavoidable. Sites are also screened for the presence of sensitive species. Our rapid response protocol is now being applied throughout the approximate 3,000 mile pipeline network we currently service in the Northeast and Mid-West.

Additionally, RedHorse has negotiated, developed, and implemented mitigation and compensation packages for clients that satisfy State and Army CORPS of Engineers regulatory requirements including wetland enhancement and design/build projects.
